I. Policy

This 2023 policy update changed the number. No other edits were made.

II. Guidelines

The battery shut-off switch must be in the OFF position at the end of shift or when a vehicle is exchanged. The switch must be off regardless of the vehicle being parked in the designated area or at Fleet for repairs.

A battery disconnect switch cuts off the connection between a battery and accessories that can drain it. Putting the cut-off switch in the OFF position:

- Lowers the chances of the battery malfunctioning
- Helps protects against electrical fires
- Reduces theft

III. Disciplinary Action

Violations of this policy will lead to progressive disciplinary action.
